## From the Pastor's Study

My observation over the years is that God's people are a very generous people. They love to share what they have if they can identify some people who have genuine needs. It is difficult for them to separate the truly needy from the con artist, the people who feel they are entitled, those who are propagating a life style of continuing generational poverty. As many of you know, several of us here in the community began, almost a year ago, developing a ministry that would address the needs of the poor and needy through a holistic approach that would not only meet some immediate needs but also invite some to begin a journey that could transform their lives. We call this Mission Marshall.

A number of you have indicated interest in volunteering to work with such a venture. Our church has chosen to include Mission Marshall in this year's budget. I am happy to report to you that we now have a place, a location, out of which to work. It is at 2109 S. Washington. It is the grey building at the corner of Pinecrest and S. Washington currently occupied by a church called Family Life Outreach Center. That church family is in the processing of relocating to the facility next to the Soda Lake Baptist Association Office. This facility that will be new to them, is the building formerly occupied by the Agape Church. Mission Marshall will be allowed to take possession of their new location on S. Washington during this month of February and begin to make some internal changes that will accommodate their anticipated ministries. Mission Marshall has a Director, Mrs. Doretha Hicks, who will be relocating in the new facility when her office is completed. As you pray, lift up this new ministry. It has the potential to be used of God to make a huge impact on our community.

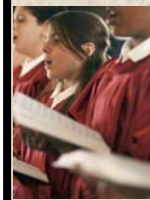
